Directions to Cornwall Energy Recovery Centre (CERC)

The CERC is located between St Austell and Newquay in central Cornwall. Access is easiest from the A30, which is the main trunk road running down the centre of the county from the M5 at Exeter.

The post code for the CERC is PL26 7QP which will take you to the top of the approach road.

Follow A30 until you see the sign titled "HIGHGATE HILL" A39 Newquay /St Dennis /Airport.

Take the first left off this roundabout exit on to the B3279. After approximately 200 meters you will come to a roundabout. Take the second exit (straight over) marked Treviscoe and Parkandillick.

Continue along this road for approximately 2 miles. Just before you enter Treviscoe, you will see a turning on the left between high Cornish walls, just after two boarded up houses.

This is the approach road to the Cornwall Energy Recovery Centre, proceed down the approach road, taking the left hand lane, until you reach the barrier. If you are arriving in a coach or mini bus please park in the bus bay (point 10 on the map). If you are travelling by car, please reverse park in the visitor/ disabled bays outside the main entrance to the visitors centre. You will be met by a member of staff, who will escort you to the main reception where we will ask you to sign in the visitors signing in book.

When leaving site, please ensure you have signed out of the building, drive out of the site and using the left hand lane, as you approach the barrier to leave.

NB:

1. There is a 20mph speed limit on the approach road; when moving around the site, there is 10mph speed limit.

2. Be aware of traffic movement on and around site; follow signage and road markings and in particular, instructions given by site staff en route.
